System Wide Smoking Ban and AS Book Trade Website

WHEREAS, the mission of Associated Students is to provide a means for responsible and effective participation in the governance of the campus, to provide an official voice through which students' opinions may be expressed, and to assist in the protection of the rights and interests of the individual and the student body; and,

WHEREAS, the Associated Students of Humboldt State University believe in the democratic process and the rights of individuals to make decisions about issues that affect their lives; and,
